Introduction

With this paper we aim to analyze the flow of external trade export and import in Kosovo according to the main groups of export and import such as comprise of metals, mineral products, chemical industry, plastics, tires, herbal products, food prepared, beverages and tobacco, machinery, appliances and electronics, chemical industry products, textile and textile articles etc, defined by value and percentage

Regarding the export and import of Kosovo, the main trade partners are: 27 EU countries, countries of CEFTA, EFTA countries, other European countries, other non-European countries, Asian countries, and in other countries, defined by value and percentage.

1. Foreign trade export and import flows in Kosovo to other countries of the world

Exports in the economy means the transport of goods or materials from one place to another legitimately under the rules and standards of the countries participating in a shift goods or the goods. Exporting goods to foreign customers become in a state other than the manufacturer of those goods. Export Import adverse action is very important for a country and that country's participation in the international market.

- Major exports is positive if the value of exported goods (exchanged for currency) is greater than the value of imported goods.
- Major exports is negative if the value of exported goods (exchanged for currency) is less than the value of imported goods.

Imports in economics known as transportation (entrance) of goods, products from one country to another country in a legitimate manner and under defined economic policy of countries participating in Retail. Unlike the export of goods implies the emergence of a country, as imports from a country that enters a commodity is calculated from a different place in that country. 95

1.1. Exports and imports by sections of products in value and in percentage

According to the main groups of export: the exports consists of base metals and articles thereof, mineral products, plastics, rubber and articles thereof, vegetable products, prepared foodstuffs, beverages and tobacco, textile and textile articles etc, in value and percentage

While according to the groups for import: import of mineral products, prepared foodstuffs, beverages and tobacco, machinery, mechanical and electrical equipment, base metals and articles thereof, chemical industry products, plastics, rubber and articles thereof, etc, in value and percentage.
